Who & why?

This webinar is the first in a series of cross-fertilization activities meant to **develop synergies across parallel worlds** with different programme strategies but similar policy and sustainability objectives in the **field of water management, restoration and depollution.** In particular, this activity seeks to build a link between the implementation of the <u>EU Mission Restore</u> Our Ocean & Waters in the Mediterranean via the BlueMissionMed (BMM) project

with institutional and project-related stakeholders belonging to the world of the Interreg Euro-MED programme. Conversely, in the Interreg Euro-MED, the institutional dialogue project Dialogue4Innovation (D4I) belongs to the Innovative Sustainable Economy (ISE) Mission, holding transversal policy and community engagement activities on both the Green & Blue Economy. Through its own Liaising4Advocacy strategy, the D4I (& sister project C4I) seek to involve Thematic Projects from all 4 Euro-MED Mission (ISE, Green & Living Areas, Natural Heritage, Sustainable Tourism) in order to develop potential synergies with the EU Mission Ocean & Waters.

This event is co-organised by project partners across the two projects: IFREMER, CPMR-IMC, CNR, FVA, Emilia-Romagna Region (ERR). Liaising for cross-cooperation is sponsored by CPMR-IMC, partner in both projects.

For Whom?

The Webinar potentially targets a broad audience, including:

- EU Mission representatives
- Staff from the Euro-MED Joint Secretariat
- The Partners of the other Euro-MED Mission Governance Projects from and beyond ISE (i.e. Tourism, Natural Heritage, Green Living Areas)
- The institutional stakeholders of the Mediterranean Blue Economy • Taskforce in the framework of the BLUE ECOSYSTEM project (e.g. WestMed, EC reps from DG Mare, UfM ...)
- All of the Euro-MED projects across the four missions mainly dealing with innovative solutions/methodologies for water management, restoration and depollution

What?

In PART 1, the BlueMissionMed project and the ISE Mission Governance Projects exchange knowledge and opportunities for synergies and cooperation by presenting main activities and results. Other relevant Euro-MED Missions and institutional stakeholders can also intervene and offer their own ideas for synergies. For example, BlueMissionMed will propose its own showcase of identified innovative solutions for water depollution¹ or the BMM Support Programme for upscale and implementation of solutions directed at both providers and solution seekers. Meanwhile, the ISE Mission will illustrate the Community Engagement opportunities of the Innovative Sustainable Economy Community (ISEC) Hub of the Mediterranean, alongside the opportunities for involvement in policy lab activities (e.g., CPMR-IMC TIPL on Sustainable Water Management in 2026). All other participants (projects, institutions) are welcome to join and/or get more info about these activities.

PART 2 is entirely dedicated to Euro-MED Projects across the 4 Missions (ISE, Green & Living Areas, Natural Heritage, Sustainable Tourism. The
