The **Innovative Sustainable Economy Mission** of the **Interreg Euro-MED Programme** promotes the diffusion of methodological frameworks, tools and solutions for place-based transformative innovation.

Connecting and strengthening collaboration between local and place-based innovation ecosystems with broader interregional networks is key to addressing urgent sustainable development challenges in the Mediterranean more effectively.

The 2025 Innovation Camp, organised in collaboration with the **Joint Reaserch Centre**, is the third edition and will be hosted in Portugal (Olhao, Faro). It will focus on **three challenges related to climate adaptation and resilience of the agri-food systems**, including poor soil health, biodiversity loss, and weak climate resilience; **water scarcity** amid extreme weather events; high emissions and **non-circular agri-food supply chains**. In different sessions and working groups, we will explore the methods, spaces, governance models, policies, and technologies needed to better address these challenges moving towards more sustainable models. The ISE Mission aims to promote synergies and collaboration with other European projects and initiatives that advance place-based transformation through innovation across the European Union. In this case, the Mission is aligning with the **EU Preparatory Action 'Innovation for place-based transformation'** supported by the Joint Research Centre.

Moreover, this camp builds on the outcome of the event **Living-Labs for mitigating climate change in agriculture** jointly organised and supported by several projects and organisations.
