### New generation of cooperation

- 1. 2021-27 Special focus on synergies across Interreg and beyond.
- 2. Although the projects are starting now the discussion about the future of cooperation and possible modifications are starting in 2024.

### **Roles when addressing synergies**

- 1. Project partners as agents to work in complementarity with other funds
- 2. Project partners as agents for place based solutions- Put the territoriality in the center.
- Programmes as facilitators through levant calls, platforms,
  mechanisms etc

### Governance project work is not starting from the scratch.


### Still need to reinforce...
