



#### The Multilevel perspective, MLP





# The multilevel perspective for transformative innovation... also for depopulation challenge in rural areas



It is about identifying windows of opportunity and aligning efforts and resources (bottom-up / place-based) to develop alternatives that reconfigure the dominant system in the desired directions (SDGs)
